DUROPROOF[™] BLF forms a flexible fibre reinforced waterproof lining to all common building materials-metal, asbestos, slate, felt, asphalt, concrete, wood and plastic.

APPLICATION

Thoroughly clean and remove all loose dirt, rust, oil, flaking paint to give a sound surface.

Apply DUROPROOF[™] BLF liberally by brush and roller spreading the compound to a thickness of approx 1.5-2.0mm, taking care to work the compound well into the surface. Spread evenly before the material begins to dry. Two coats may be necessary to ensure an adequate dry film thickness, particularly on rusted surfaces. Rust holes and splits are repaired by laying fiberglass into the first coat, then applying a further coat.
